Arizona Drought Information and Preparedness Plan

Arizona is experiencing a drought which has multiple impacts on our water supply in Southern Arizona. A Tier 1 Colorado River Shortage was declared in August which will result in a substantial cut to Arizona's share of Colorado River Water and given the recent intensification of the drought, deeper levels of shortage are likely in the next few years. There has been planning and preparation for this for many years. The big question is always - Is Arizona going to run out of water. The answer is -No. In fact, everyone is working harder to ensure that water has a sustainable future in our state. We can all do our part to conserve water; every drop counts! We have a Drought Preparedness Plan posted on the avrawater.com website which is based on Pima County's unincorporated Drought Preparedness Plan and are currently in a Drought Stage I. Voluntary reductions in water use are encouraged. This means check your toilets, pour unused water or ice in your plants, check your irrigation system for breaks or reduce the time it runs, and make sure it is watering plants and not walkways or dirt. Customer Service Tips

Do You Know Where Your Water Meter and Gate Valve are Located? We receive many calls from customers asking for assistance with their meter and how to turn their water on and off. While we are happy to help everyone and will gladly send a technician out to help you locate your meter, your gate valve, and show you how to read the leak indicator at no cost during normal business hours, when a call comes in after our regular business hours, our on-call technician will let you know that there is a \$50.00 after hours charge for coming out to assist you with these problems. PLEASE be proactive and make sure you know how to get to your meter and shut it off BEFORE an emergency comes up. You will also want to keep your meter box clean of dirt and debris and make sure vou turn your gate valve periodically to ensure it is operating properly in case you need to use it in the event of a water emergency.
