Water Conservation Grant

We are excited to announce that we have received a grant from the Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) to expand our Water Conservation program. We will be providing rebates for our members for the following items:

High Efficiency Toilets: \$100 Rebate (up to 2 per household)

High Efficiency Clothes Washers: \$250 Rebate (1 per household)

High Efficiency Dishwashers: \$150 Rebate (1 per household)

Contact the office for more information and an application for any of these water conserving appliances.

Watch for more information in our newsletters and on our website at www.avrawater.com. We will be offering Water Harvesting Rebates and workshops and expanding our conservation products which currently include low flow shower heads, faucet aerators, and toilet flappers all at no charge.

Rebates will be available until WIFA grant funds have been expended.

2023 Annual Water Quality Report

The United States enjoys one of the world's most reliable and safest supplies of drinking water. Congress passed the [Safe Drinking Water Act \(SDWA\)](#) in 1974 to protect public health, including by regulating public water systems.

The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) requires EPA to [establish and enforce standards](#) that public drinking water systems must follow.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) requires all public water suppliers serving the same people year-round to provide a Consumer Confidence Report (or Annual Water Report) to their customers every year. The results of these tests are reported to the AZ Department of Environmental Quality—Water Quality Division and a summary is delivered to customers once a year.

WIFA Smart Meter Grant

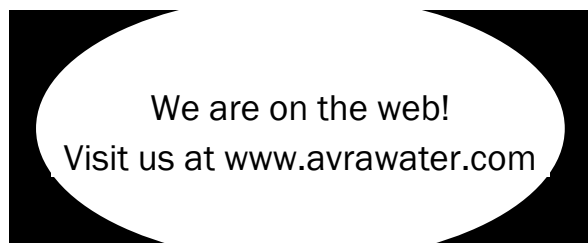
We received a second grant from WIFA to purchase smart meters. These meters will allow you to monitor your usage, water patterns, detect leaks, and identify high usage. If you receive an Avra Water blue tag notification that a new smart meter has been installed at your home, please contact our office to have a link emailed to you from the WaterScope App. This is how you will get your data from the meter.

This new smart meter program will be an ongoing project for the co-op. Over the next year 1,000 meters will be installed.
